The Need for More Space

For over 100 years the Library has served our community as a hub for activities, information gather and learning. The Library opened the doors of its original building on June 27, 1914.

In 1986, that original building was razed, and the current structure was built. The interior of the Library, including the basement, was completely remodeled in 1999, and refurbished in 2010. Since then, the Library has grown in books, members and services...but not in space.

Due to increased demand for services and technology, the 13,500 square foot building became inadequate long ago.

Groups of residents are turned away from classes and events because they can't fit into the space. 736 residents were turned away or put on waiting lists in 2018. Work space, leisure/reading space and storage is extremely limited.

The Plan: A New Library with Flexible Space

\$1,400,000 for a 21,000 sq. ft. Library costing approximately \$11 million
